



Urination Policy

This policy is intended to ensure public respect and consideration while on the roads and pathways for our safety and to ensure continued access to public places. It is also intended to protect any potential sensitivities of our own Members.

If you are someone who feels the need to urinate roadside, please:

1. Use public facilities where possible, or
2. Find a discrete location.

It is not appropriate to urinate around places of business or homes. CCC members must be considerate of other people's property.

The Policy

No rider will urinate in public or within the vicinity of a public or private property prior, during or immediately after a CCC ride unless in a proper facility. Anyone caught urinating at common ride locations will be asked to leave the ride. There is no tolerance for violation.

If a Ride Leader asks you to leave for violation and you do not leave you will be reported to the Disciplinary Committee.

Ride Leaders should consider stops at locations with public facilities, however it is permissible for a roadside stop during a ride. Keep in mind that riders will likely use the stop to urinate. This is not encouraged but we it does not violate this policy assuming it is NOT in the vicinity of a public area (park, busy road, business, church, or private home). Ideally, we stop at different locations each ride.
